## Reminder: Change to Resident Stat Holiday Pay in New Collective Agreement

The change in language provides that the shift has to start on the statutory holiday in order to be eligible for the premium statutory holiday pay. It is now mandatory for residents to include the shift schedule (start and end time) when submitting Stat Holiday Payment in RMS. Time off in lieu should not be tracked in RMS.
