Resident Wellness Office Updates

Wellness Champions Network:

The Resident Wellness Office is recruiting for our Wellness Champions Network!

Wellness Champions are ambassadors for wellness within their residency program / site through the encouragement of dialogue around wellness in

residency, sharing wellness communication from the Resident Wellness Office, remaining familiar with support services and wellness resources, serving as a wellness contact for peers, and providing feedback to the Resident Wellness Office related to the needs of their program / site. Most importantly, the Wellness Champion role does not counsel or advise others; rather, Wellness Champions can have comfortable conversations about wellness-related concerns with peers and will refer to appropriate resources as appropriate.

The Wellness Champions Network involves both residents and faculty to facilitate the sharing of ideas and critical discussion related to resident wellness at UBC. You can find out more information and sign up on the <u>Resident Wellness Office website</u>.

Peer-Led Ice Cream Rounds:

In addition to the wide range of performances, Resident Talent Night also features a physical and digital art exhibit, showcasing photography, painting and drawing submissions from residents across the province.

Reminders for Submitting Resident Reimbursement Claims

The PGME office receives many resident reimbursement claims every day. To help speed up the reimbursement process for residents, please remember the following tips:

1. **Original receipts**: residents must submit original receipts with all of their reimbursement claims. If a resident does not include original

receipts in their claim, please ask them to send you the originals before you forward the claim on to the PGME office.

- Missing Receipt Form: <u>Missing Receipt Forms</u> must be signed by residents and programs and proof of payment must be attached. Missing receipts that are paid by cash are not eligible for reimbursement.
- Direct Deposit Enrollment for Reimbursement: residents are highly encouraged to enroll in direct deposit for reimbursement. Residents should complete the <u>Direct Deposit Authorization Form</u> and submit to Vancouver Coastal Health directly (address listed on the form). Do not submit the form to the PGME office.
- 4. Quick Tickets for Harbour Air Seaplanes: The usage of quick tickets which are prepaid by the PGME office must be indicated in the Resident Reimbursement Form. The PGME office will include the total cost of these tickets in the transportation allowance and pay the remaining balance up to the maximum amount per policy.
- 5. **Mileage**: When residents are taking ferries, the mileage between 2 ferry terminals should be removed from the mileage calculation.
