The health authorities are hosting a provincial occupational health and safety orientation for all residents commencing a UBC residency program on June 26, 2020. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the event will consist of a virtual orientation session on Zoom approximately 4 hours in duration, as well as a series of online modules that must be completed before July 1, 2020.

The provincial OH&S orientation will include, but is not limited to:

1. Health Authority OH&S Overview
2. Provincial Violence Prevention Curriculum (PVPC) E-Learning Module
3. Workplace Hazardous Material Information System (WHMIS)
4. *Musculoskeletal* Prevention Program (*MSIP*)
5. Hazardous/Cytotoxic Drug Awareness
6. Infection Prevention and Control
7. Radiation Safety Basics

Provided you attend the virtual session on June 26, 2020 and complete the online modules in advance of July 1, 2020, you will be provided with a lieu day or two partial lieu days by your residency program during the academic year, on a date determined by your residency program.
