

COVID-19 Quick Reference Sheet – Years 3 and 4 Students

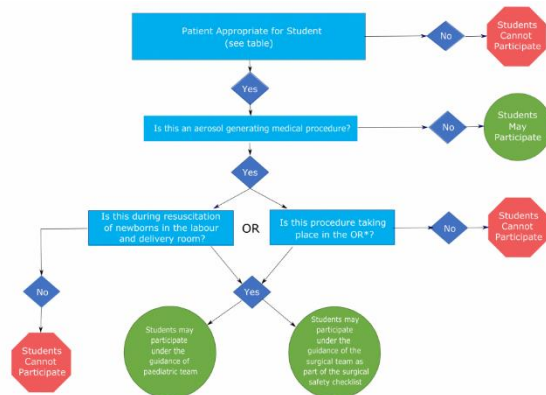
What type of patients can students see during their clinical experiences?

All patients should be screened for suitability before students are involved with in-person care. Students are permitted to participate in in-person care of patients in the groups identified by a green check mark **provided appropriate PPE is available**. The attending physician and team may further use their discretion for student involvement in low-moderate pretest probability cases, and students always have the right to refuse work they feel is unsafe. Any guidelines specific to a student’s hospital site or Health Authority still apply.

What aerosol generating medical procedures (AGMP) procedures can students participate in?



Students may participate in **all non-AGMP's**.

Students may participate in **AGMP's as follows:**

- When in the OR with a low risk patient under the guidance of the Operating Room team via the Surgical Safety checklist.
- In the resuscitation of a newborn in the LDR under the guidance of the Pediatric team as evidence suggests that the rate of vertical transmission of COVID-19 is low.
