<sup>11.02</sup> If a statutory holiday falls within a Resident's vacation, or on their regularly scheduled day off, or when they are on call as per Article 19.02, the Resident shall receive an alternate day off without loss of pay. Residents will make reasonable efforts to take the alternate day off without loss of pay in the block it is earned. Regardless, a Resident can take this alternate day within 12 months of earning it on a date mutually agreed between the Resident and the Residency Program.

<sup>11.04</sup> Every Resident shall be entitled to at least five (5) consecutive days off during the fourteen (14) day period that encompasses Christmas, New Year's Day and two (2) full weeneds. Those five (5) days off are to account for the three (3) statutory holidays, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, and two (2) 24-hour periods of scheduled non-working time.
